5.02.2026 Heard Sri. D.K.Pathak on behalf of the appellant, who filed an I.A. petition praying for quashing the Notice dated 13 January' 2026 issued by Respondent JBVNL by which appellant has been asked to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,58,267 within 15 days, or else the electric supply would be disconnected. Learned counsel also briefly explained the background of this appeal. It is submitted that he has been regularly paying the current bills and the impugned notice has been issued showing the dues which is subject matter of the appeal, 50% whereof has already been deposited in terms of Section 56 proviso of Electricity Act, 2003. He prays for the staying of notice.

Heard Sri. Utpal Kant, the learned counsel for JBVNL who factually accepts the submission made on behalf of the appellant.

Under the circumstances above stated, Respondent JBVNL is directed not to act upon the notice of disconnection, communicated to the appellant, the Principal Vikas Vidyalaya vide letter No. 205/ESC, Ranchi dated 13th of January'2026 till further orders.
